## PCPIR

## A Brief Report INDIA CHEM 2008

India Chem 2008 – the latest in the series was held from 20th - 22nd October at Bombay Exhibition Centre, Mumbai. The event was a grand success with 55% participation from overseas. Hon'ble Minister of Chemicals, Fertilizers & Steel, Shri Ram Vilas Paswan inaugurated the event.

## Highlights of the event INDIA CHEM 2008

**262 companies participated at the event, out of which 146 were from 17 countries** - Iran, Switzerland, USA, UK, Russia, Austria, Sweden, Saudi Arabia, Finland, Italy, Japan, China, France, Germany, Belgium, Korea & Singapore.

- 18,594 Trade visitors from 59 countries attended the show.

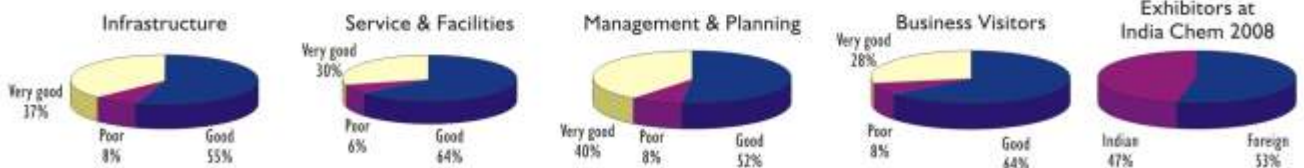
